### **ABOUT THE CAMP**

\*\* This camp is held to get a head start on marching fundamentals, pre-game and half-time show, and for the band to get together and know each other (185 members). Due to the confusion a space makes on the field if even one person is absent, it is integral that all members are present every day. Each student will learn over 20 moves on the field and over 10 songs. If a student is not able to make a day, the parent needs to contact Mr. Stahly as soon as they can so arrangements can be made.
